

## **SLBT Update for the Week of September 2, 2019**

- The Tagging Committee did not meet last week as it was decided to meet again after the internal SLBT meeting. The Tagging Committee will be meeting on Thursday, September 5 at 4:00p.m. to discuss any new findings or thoughts on the proposed solutions.
- Tagging Committee members are continuing to look for an acceptable cable/swage system that if hacked, will be easily identifiable by staff. Currently the focus is on finding a swage that is smooth, solid and does not have creases that make any manipulation hard to detect.
- Staff received from Noke the prototype of the integrated cable/lock system. Staff continues to have issues with the software/firmware that Noke uses. The prototype utilizes the “unshackle” feature vs. the “unlock” feature and currently does not record the location of the opening of the lock at all. This software issue is being addressed by Noke but the timeframe is currently unknown. Noke is preparing to introduce new software for the Noke lock in January 2020. Once a new software version is rolled out, IT staff will vet the new version.
