

ADAMS COUNTY

The Severe Weather Activation Program (SWAP) will activate when:

- ❄ Temperatures drop to **32°F** or under wet
- ❄ Temperatures drop to **20°F** or under dry

Eligible literal homeless households may receive a hotel/motel voucher through case managers.

JEFFERSON COUNTY


The Severe Weather Shelter Network operates from October through April when:

- ❄ Nighttime low temperatures are projected to be **32°F** or colder and wet
- ❄ Nighttime low temperatures are projected to be **20°F** or colder and dry
- ❄ Cold weather activation may be suspended based on additional factors

Additional resources:

- ❄ When temperatures are projected to be **10°F** or colder for 48 hours or more, Jeffco will deploy a mobile shelter and announce details.

CITY OF WESTMINSTER

The City will activate an emergency cold weather shelter at The MAC (3295 W. 72nd Ave.) to supplement county services when:

- ❄ Temperatures are projected to be **0°F**
- ❄ Sustained windchill is projected to be below **0°F** for six hours or more

Homeless navigators also distribute hotel vouchers provided by Jeffco, Adams County, and the City of Westminster to their clients.
