



Golf Westminster Legacy Ridge and Walnut Creek SoloRider FAQ's

What is an ADA cart (SoloRider)?

This single rider adaptive golf cart is meant for people with a wide array of different disabilities. The cart is specially designed to drive nearly anywhere on the golf course with minimal impact. This vehicle offers the golfer many different features including a seat that raises and swivels to orient the golfer to a near standing position to hit golf shots, an automatic braking system to keep the cart steady during a swing, and an all-wheel drive system that helps the cart drive in rough, fairway, bunkers, and greens.



How do I reserve the cart?

Tee-times may be made online 14-days in advance. Once tee-times have been made, both Legacy Ridge and Walnut Creek require golfers who are planning on renting the ADA cart to call the golf shop at least 24 hours in advance. Each course only has one golf cart. To check the availability up to 14-days in advance, please call the golf shop you booked a tee-time at.

Why do I need to call ahead to reserve?

This model of the SoloRider is a brand-new vehicle, and has not been 'broken in,' yet. Therefore, both golf courses require a pre-use inspection to ensure the vehicle is adequately charged, batteries have been watered, and other needed preventative maintenance is completed. The SoloRider company recommends these inspections be completed before and after each use until the batteries have been 'primed.' (25-50 uses) Therefore we ask for a call-in advance so these protocols can be completed.


What should I expect when I arrive?

Legacy Ridge and Walnut Creek ask all golfers to arrive with adequate time to familiarize themselves with the cart, especially if it your first use with the vehicle. The reason being is the advanced features the golf cart offers including the hydraulic seat and automatic braking system. Familiarity with the vehicle beforehand will create a fluent and seamless round.

The vehicle is a very manageable and straightforward golf cart that is not difficult to use on the course. Though, we want to ensure everyone using it has a memorable experience, which is why we go to lengths to tailor our operations to providing a golf cart in exceptional shape and ease of use.

How much does it cost to rent?

Standard cart fees apply. 18-Holes: \$20+tax, and for 9-holes \$11+tax.
