

Question	Answer
<b>Splash pads</b>	Operate Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. These may be shut off at any time during the season due to weather, maintenance, or other operational concerns. Dogs are not allowed in water play features. Water balloons are not allowed at any pavilion.
<b>Rental Hours</b>	All rentals are 10:00am-8:00pm. No hourly rentals will be provided.
<b>Inflatables/Tents</b>	Inflatables including jump castles are not allowed in any City of Westminster parks. Tents 10ft x 10ft and smaller are permitted.
<b>Alcohol (at reservable pavilions only)</b>	An alcohol permit may be purchased with the reservation of a pavilion. A driver's license is required to show proof of age. The name of the ID must match the name on the reservation. Beer and wine only, no glass or kegs allowed. Permit holder is responsible and assumes all risk regarding liabilities that may arise by those attending and drinking alcohol during the rental. Applicant is responsible for ensuring that all persons who drink are of legal age and all state alcohol laws are obeyed. Applicant must be on site during rental and keep approved permits on hand at all times.
<b>Grill Use</b>	If a grill is provided in the park renters may use it. However, grills cannot be brought into City of Westminster Parks.

<b>Pavilion Area and Parks</b>	Pavilion rental is for the pavilion area only. Parks and playgrounds are open to the public.
<b>Animal Restrictions</b>	Animals must be on a leash at all times. See City Municipal Code for animal restrictions within parks.
<b>Cancellation Process</b>	\$10 cancellation fee assessed with a minimum 15-day prior notice to scheduled event. No refunds are issued for cancellations within 14 days.
<b>Electricity</b>	Electricity is provided at parks, outlets are 15-20amps. On occasion, outlets at pavilions may be out of order.
<b>Music/Amplified Sound</b>	Amplified music is not allowed in City of Westminster parks.
<b>Restroom Access</b>	All pavilions have either a restroom or a port-a-let. Should a restroom be out of service, a port-a-let will be provided.
<b>Selling of Items</b>	Selling of items is not allowed in City of Westminster Parks
<b>Inclement Weather</b>	Refunds will not be issued due to weather. However, reservations can be rescheduled based on availability.
<b>Reservation Age Requirements</b>	Renters must be 21 years old to reserve a pavilion.
<b>NO Driving in park</b>	Cars must remain in parking lots and not driven to pavilions per City Code.
<b>Parking</b>	Designated parking is available at some of the parks and is available first come first serve to all park users. The majority of the parks have limited street parking and it is recommended that large groups carpool.
<b>Decorations</b>	Decorations are allowed at all City of Westminster Pavilions <b>Pinatas, confetti, glitter and water balloons are not allowed.</b> Renters are responsible for disposal of all decoration after rental has ended. Any costs for damages done to the pavilion by decorations will be the responsibility of the renter.
