 - Transportation and Mobility presentation
 - Chris Chovan, Senior Transportation and Mobility Planner for City of Westminster
 - Via Mobility: Provides on-call transportation service for residents 60 and over and/or are mobility-challenged. Just started July 1, 2025. Free for residents. Funded by City Council. Board expressed interest in getting message out to more residents. Will follow up with City Communications to see what is possible. Ideas suggested such as including in water bill.
 - A-Lift: Provides on-call transportation service for residents 60 and over and/or are mobility-challenged. Funded by City via Adams County.
 - Access Ride: Provides on-demand transportation service for those who are mobility-challenged through RTD. Available within $\frac{3}{4}$ mile of existing RTD route. Cost for user.
 - Federal Boulevard BRT: Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) running from Wagon Road to Englewood Station. Target Jan 2030.
 - Regional transportation involvement: participation in Denver Regional Council of Governments (DRCOG), stakeholder cooperation with neighboring governments. Participation in subregional organizations.
 - Election of officers (Vice Chair) – Received Justin’s resignation today. Will postpone election of Vice Chair until September where elections for both Chair and Vice Chair will be held.
