- Welcome
- Review and Approve Minutes
  - Steve motioned, Rich seconded. Approved.
- City Council Report
  - Councillor Amber Hott
    - Not present. The board has missed city council report the last couple of months. Board members will reach out.
- New Business
  - Election of officers (Chair and Vice Chair)
    - Rich is term limited in December 2025. Jillian has put name in for Chair. Steve nominated Jillian as Chair. Rich seconded. Approved. Jillian nominated Miguel as Vice Chair. Rich seconded. Approved. Will wait on Secretary election.
- Old Business
  - Building Community/Outreach
    - Jillian mentioned having bulletin boards at parks and open space to promote what is happening in the city such as programs for unhoused, translation services, community events, etc. Could talk with Parks and Recreation. Discussed being present at city events like Westyfest and finding out how other boards get communication to community.
- Community Report
  - What's Happening in the Community?
    - Jillian shared she has heard a lot of people express concern about covid vaccines and availability. May not be something city can do about it but could contact Adams and Jefferson County Public Health departments. Colorado Department of Public Health issued a statement that a prescription should not be required for a covid vaccine. Seems like it is a state health issue so may be out of the scope of this board. Questions about whether board should express concern to City Council. Miguel shared info from SRC board meeting - Adams County is discontinuing their funding for

older adults. Probably due to limited budgets. Amy shared that we do have 2 board member vacancies (posted on city's website) and encouraged members to share with community. Water treatment plant groundbreaking on Sept. 24<sup>th</sup>.
