



WHAT TO EXPECT DURING WATER SUPPLY LINE CONSTRUCTION

As construction begins, we are making every effort to minimize inconvenience and to complete work as efficiently and safely as possible.



Typical work hours will be Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. with some evening and weekend work as needed.



Expect some temporary traffic lane and sidewalk closures across the project area.



Every effort will be made to limit noise, dust, and vibrations; however, they may be present due to construction activity.



Trenches will be dug in the ground to lay new pipe in most sections of the project



Track hoes, loaders, and other heavy machinery will be used throughout construction.



Some tree removal is anticipated near the open space area east of Betty Adams Elementary.



Temporary road closures may be necessary to complete work as efficiently and safely as possible along Pierce and 96th Avenue and 98th Avenue and Westminister Boulevard.




To be good neighbors, we will bore tunnels in the following areas to minimize traffic impacts:

- BNSF crossing at Old Wadsworth
- Westminster Boulevard north of the Sports Complex
- US-36 south of Westminster Boulevard overpass



PROJECT SCHEDULE

Construction will begin this fall with work anticipated to take about three years. See the timeline for specific start and end times for each portion of the project.
