## Flood Hazard Area Delineation Study (FHAD)

### Major Drainageway Plan (MDP)

#### Project Overview:

The City of Westminster, the City of Arvada, and Adams County have partnered with Mile High Flood District (MHFD) to conduct a comprehensive study of the Little Dry Creek Basin. Little Dry Creek is a tributary of Big Dry Creek and ultimately drains eastward to the Clear Creek and the South Platte River.

MHFD completed the original flood study and drainage plan for Little Dry Creek and tributaries in 1978-1979 and is now outdated. Flood risk changes over time and the new FHAD offers an up-to-date understanding of flood risk along Little Dry Creek, Tributary B, and Shaw Heights Tributary based on current data and modern technology.

Flooding poses a significant threat to life, public health, safety, infrastructure, and private property. Ensuring that flood risk information is accurate and up to date is critical to protecting the community, guiding responsible development, informing property owners, and supporting sound long-term planning decisions.


#### Public Engagement:
