


How will your water and sewer bill be used in 2020?*



56% Infrastructure **Investments**

Capital improvement projects to replace aging infrastructure, debt payments on past infrastructure projects and investment in an emergency project fund.



17% **Personnel**

Salaries and benefits for water, wastewater and utility billing employees.



9% **Administrative** Support

Transfer to the General Fund to cover administrative services provided by the city.




8% Contractual Work / **Professional Services**

Work performed by outside contractors to help operate and maintain the utility system.



5% **Materials & Energy**

Supplies and expenses to operate the system including water supply costs.



Metro Wastewater Reclamation District

Payment for treating wastewater flows from the southern part of Westminster. By contract, Metro has been treating a portion of Westminster's wastewater since 1963.

^{*}To most accurately show how water bills will be used in 2020, this graphic does not include a \$4 million expense for water that is paid for by the cities of Brighton and Thorton, a \$1 million transfer from the wastewater fund to the water fund to cover adminstrative expenses paid for out of the water fund and about \$4 million in stormwater utility expenses.
