MEETINGS: A minimum of one formal, mandatory monthly meeting will be held from September through August on the first Thursday of each month from 6:30pm - 7:30pm. Additional monthly community service projects are planned by sitting panel members. Committee meetings may be re-scheduled by majority vote of the Youth Advisory Panel.

Westminster City Charter requires each applicant for appointment to a Board or Commission to submit an affidavit indicating whether he or she has been convicted of a felony under the laws of the State of Colorado or in another jurisdiction. Although members of the Westminster Youth Advisory Panel are not considered a Board or Commission due to charter mandate, members of the Youth Advisory Panel are representatives of the City of Westminster and are thus subject to the same review. The report of a felony shall include the type of offense, the date of the offense and may include the circumstances and any evidence of rehabilitation. Each applicant shall also give written permission for a criminal background investigation by the Westminster Police Department, who shall report to the City Clerk any felony convictions of an applicant found in their investigation. The City Clerk shall maintain the report in a file available to the public.
