CITY OF WESTMINSTER, COLORADO MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON MONDAY, JANUARY 31, 2000 AT 7:00 P.M.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

Mayor Pro Tem Dixion led Council, Staff and the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

ROLL CALL:

Present at roll call were Mayor Pro Tem Dixion and Councillors Atchison, Hicks, Merkel, Moss and Smith. Also present were William Christopher City Manager; Martin McCullough, City Attorney; and Michele Kelley, City Clerk. Mayor Heil is on an extended medical absence.

BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS:

A motion was made by Atchison and seconded by Smith to remove Resolution No. 7 making re-appointments, and Resolution No. 8 making new appointments, to the City's Boards and Commissions from the Table. The motion carried unanimously.

RESOLUTION NO. 7 - RE-APPOINTMENTS TO CITY'S BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS:

A motion was made by Atchison and seconded by Merkel to adopt Resolution No. 7 making the following Boards and Commissions re-appointments with the terms of office to expire December 31, 2001: Open Space Advisory Board – Kenneth Eichel (alternate member), Ed Getsch (regular member), Karen Scheuerman (regular member), and Randal Tucker (regular member); Parks and Recreation Advisory Board – Michele Haney (regular member), and Ronald Mayoral (moved to regular member); Personnel Board – Nicholas DiTirro (alternate member), Colleen Peace (regular member), Wesley Underwood (alternate member) and Stacy Worthington (regular member); Special Permit and License Board – Frank Jaime (moved to regular member), Tim Kauffman (regular member), and Nancy Peters (regular member), Library Board – Mary Boston (moved to regular member). Upon roll call vote, the motion carried unanimously.

RESOLUTION NO. 8 – NEW APPOINTMENTS TO CITY'S BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS:

A motion was made by Atchison and seconded by Hicks to adopt Resolution No. 8 making new appointments to Board of Adjustment – Brian Lunning (moved to regular member) and Christopher Beall (regular member) and Leisa Schievelbein as an alternate member; Board of Building Code Appeals – Steven Fenimore moved to a regular member and leave the alternate member position vacant until a later date; Environmental Advisory Board – Wendy Sukeena (regular member) and Raymond Parson (alternate member); Human Services Board – Dick Fregosi (regular member); Library Board – Hal Smith as an alternate member; Parks and Recreation Advisory Board – Stephanie Bingham as an alternate member and leave the other alternate member position vacant until a later date; Planning Commission – Rex Weiderspahn (regular member), Bill Everard (alternate member) and Bill Lord (alternate member) and Special Permit and License Board – Bill Nordberg as an alternate member.

A motion was made by Merkel and seconded by Smith to amend Resolution No. 8 to re-appoint Joseph Barsoom as a regular member and appoint Rex Weiderspahn and Bill Lord as alternate members to the Planning Commission. The amendment failed with dissenting votes by Atchison, Hicks and Moss. The main motion failed with dissenting votes by Dixion, Merkel and Smith.

A motion was made by Hicks and seconded by Smith to reconsider Resolution No. 8 and eliminate the Planning Commission appointments and making appointments to the other Boards and Commissions as listed. The motion carried with a dissenting vote by Atchison.

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Upon call for the question on Resolution No. 8 as amended making the following Boards and Commissions appointments: Board of Adjustment – Brian Lunning (moved to Regular member) and Christopher Beall with terms of office to expire December 31, 2000, and Leisa Schievelbein as an Alternate member with term of office to expire December 31, 2001; Board of Building Code Appeals – Steven Fenimore as a Regular member with term of office to expire December 31, 2001 and to leave the Alternate member position vacant until a later date; Environmental Advisory Board – Wendy Sukeena and Raymond Parson (Alternate member) with terms of office to expire December 31, 2001; Human Services Board – Dick Fregosi with term of office to expire December 31, 2001; Library Board – Hal Smith as an Alternate member with term of office to expire December 31, 2001; Parks and Recreation Advisory Board – Stephanie Bingham as an Alternate member with term of office to expire December 31, 2001; and Special Permit and License Board – Bill Nordberg as an Alternate member with term of office to expire December 31, 2001. Upon roll call vote, the motion carried with a dissenting vote by Atchison.

The date of February 7, 2000 was set for a special City Council meeting to consider the appointments to the Planning Commission. If all Councillors are not present at this meeting, the issue will be continued to the February 14, 2000 Council meeting.

APPOINTMENT OF MUNICIPAL COURT PUBLIC DEFENDER:

A motion was made by Moss and seconded by Hicks to authorize the Mayor Pro Tem to execute an agreement with Beth Ann Faragher for Municipal Court Public Defender services for the twelve month period beginning February 1, 2000. The motion carried unanimously.

MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS:

The Mayor Pro Tem stated there would be an Executive Session regarding real estate negotiations and TheButterfly Pavilion negotiations.

Introduction

City Council action is requested to make new appointments to various City Boards and Commissions where vacancies currently exist.

Summary

City Council tabled action on this item at the January 24th Council meeting.

On Monday, January 17th and Tuesday, January 18th, City Council interviewed all of the 15 new applicants for the 2000 pool for Board and Commission vacancies. Introduction

City Council action is requested to consider the re-appointments to the Open Space Advisory Board, Parks and Recreation Advisory Board, Personnel Board, Planning Commission, Special Permit and License Board and Transportation Commission where terms of office expired on December 31, 1999.

Summary

City Council tabled action on this item at the January 24th Council meeting.

In 1993, Council implemented a performance feedback system in conjunction with the consideration of reappointment of individual Board and Commission members when terms of office were to expire. The Chairperson and Vice Chair of each Board were requested to give performance feedback to Council. This information has previously been submitted to City Council. Beginning in 1994, Council has considered the various re-appointments over several Council meeting periods.

Each individual whose term expired December, 1999 was contacted and asked if they were interested in being re-appointed to the Board, if Council so desires. The re-appointments are for a two year term.

Staff Recommendation

Remove this item from the Table and adopt Resolution No. 7 making re-appointments to the Open Space Advisory Board, Parks and Recreation Advisory Board, Personnel Board, Planning Commission, Special Permit and License Board and Transportation Commission, with all terms to expire on December 31, 2001.

Background Information

The terms of office of four of the Open Space Advisory Board members expired on December 31, 1999. Kenneth Eichel (Alternate member); Ed Getsch, Karen Scheuerman and Randal Tucker are all interested in being reappointed to the Open Space Advisory Board.

The terms of office of two of the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board members expired on December 31, 1999. Michele Haney and Ronald Mayoral (Alternate member) are both interested in being reappointed to the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board. Gary Lovato has recently moved out of Westminster.

The terms of office of four of the Personnel Board members expired on December 31, 1999. Nicholas DiTirro (Alternate member); Colleen Peace, Wesley Underwood (Alternate member) and Stacy Worthington have all indicated that they are interested in being re-appointed to the Personnel Board.

The terms of office of two of the Planning Commission members expired on December 31, 1999. Joseph Barsoom and James Boschert (Alternate member) are interested in being re-appointed to the Planning Commission.
