

Introduction

City Council is requested to take action on Councillor's Bill No. 81 approving a Preannexation Agreement involving approximately 160 acres of land owned by Charles E. Foster at the northeast corner of 136th Avenue and Huron Street. The property has approximately 1/2 mile of frontage each on Huron Street, 136th Avenue and I-25.

Summary

The proposed Preannexation Agreement establishes the terms and conditions under which the Foster property would be annexed to the City. The agreement provides that annexation and zoning of the property will occur within 90 days of the execution of the preannexation agreement. The agreement contemplates that the zoning will allow a variety of retail, office and business park uses.

The agreement is consistent with the City's proaction to support the construction of a new interchange along I-25 at 136th Avenue. The agreement also contemplates the formation of one or more types of special districts to help to finance construction of the interchange.

Staff Recommendation

Adopt Councillor's Bill No. 81 as an emergency ordinance approving the preannexation agreement with Charles E. Foster for property located at the northeast corner of Huron Street and 136th Avenue and authorizing the City Manager to sign this agreement.

Background Information

The Foster property extends from Huron Street to I-25 along 136th Avenue. The property is bordered on the south, west and east by the City of Westminster. The property has the potential for development into a high quality office/retail/business park planned development.

Colorado law allows municipalities to execute preannexation agreements with land owners to prescribe the circumstances under which annexation will occur. The primary features of the Foster Preannexation Agreement include:

- 1. Within 90 days after execution of this agreement, the owner shall submit an annexation petition and application for zoning.
- 2. The zoning will be vested for a period of 10 years after the approval.
- 3. Foster agrees to participate in special districts for financing interchanges at 128th Avenue, 136th Avenue and 144th Avenue.
- 4. The City agrees to support the 136th Avenue as the first priority interchange to be constructed north of 120th Avenue.

Some alternatives to this action include:

- a) Do not approve the Preannexation Agreement and do not pursue annexation of the Foster property.
- b) Seek to renegotiate the terms of the Preannexation Agreement.

Staff does not support either alternative. The Foster property is highly desirable to annex to the City given its great economic development potential. Staff has spent many hours negotiating what it believes to be a fair and equitable agreement with Ed Sutton, the agent for Mr. Foster.
