Summary Statement:

This report is for City Council information only and requires no action by City Council.

- The following report updates 2009 residential development activity per subdivision (please see attachment) and compares 2009 year-to-date (April) totals with 2008 year-to-date (April) figures.
- The table below shows an overall decrease (-80.4%) in new residential construction for 2009 year-to-date when compared to 2008 year-to-date totals.
- Residential development activity in April 2009 reflects no change in single-family detached (3 units for both years), a decrease in single-family attached (0 versus 6 in 2008), and no change in multi-family or senior housing development when compared to the April totals in 2008 (0 for both years).
