No person shall make a contribution to a candidate committee, issue committee, political committee, small donor committee, or political party with the expectation that some or all of the amounts of such contribution will be reimbursed by another person. No person shall be reimbursed for a contribution made to any candidate committee, issue committee, political

committee, small donor committee, or political party, nor shall any person make such reimbursement except as provided in subsection (8) of this section. [Art. XXVIII, Sec. 3(8)]
