

IRC Residential Pool/Inground Spa Permit Submittal Requirements

- ALL pools, except those that are above ground and have a maximum water depth
 of less than 24 inches, require a permit. Pools are covered by the 2015 International
 Swimming Pool and Spa Code, 2020 NEC, and the City's code amendments.
- The City of Westminster does <u>not</u> issue separate permits for electrical, gas line, mechanical, or fencing/barrier work associated with a pool install. The City of Westminster issues one permit for all the work.
- Provide a building permit application filled out with all appropriate information.
 Provide one copy of the application, two copies of the site plan and engineering documents, and one copy of all equipment cut sheets.
- Provide a signed (by owner) notarized City pool contract form.
- Provide a site plan. The site plan must address the following requirements:
 - The site plan must be drawn to scale and the scale indicated.
 - Indicate the location of the pool on the lot. Include the distance from the pool to property lines.
 - Indicate the location and provide description of the barrier required by IRC section AG105.2. Provide a dimensioned elevational view of the barrier. Provide sufficient information to allow for the reviewer to determine that the barrier is in full compliance with the Code.
 - Indicate any glazing that is within 5-ft of the water's edge of the pool and where the bottom edge of the glazing is less than 5-ft above the adjacent walking surface.
 - Indicate any overhead electrical wires that pass over the pool location and the anticipated height above the water's surface. Confirm on the plans if overhead wires exist.
 - If a powered safety cover complying with ASTM F 1346 is being provided, please provide manufacturer data and testing certification information.
 - Indicate the location of the pool equipment. Mark on the site plan where heaters, pumps, filters, etc. are being installed. Provide dimensions from the equipment to the property lines.
- Address in the application, "description of work" field or on the drawings, what is being provided for electrical. Is the electrical feed surface run, fed overhead, or run underground?
- Address in the "description of work" field of the application, if the pool is being heater or not. If heated, provide equipment cut sheets. Provide gas pipe plan with equipment submittal.

•	If the pool is an in-ground pool, provide fully engineered drawings, wet stamped by a Colorado registered engineer. Provide a soils report if available. If the pool is cast against existing soil (gunited pool) or backfilled with existing soils, provide maximum fluid pressure that the design is based on.
