VERIFICATION OF LAWFUL PRESENCE TO RECEIVE PUBLIC BENEFITS

As of August 1, 2006, Colorado state law requires individuals and sole proprietors applying for local public benefits to complete **<u>both</u>** Section I and Section II below.

Section I. - Affidavit

I swear or affirm under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of Colorado that (check only one):

- I am a United States citizen, or
- I am a Permanent Resident of the United States, or
- I am lawfully present in the United States pursuant to Federal law.

I understand that this sworn statement is required by law because I have applied for a public benefit. I understand that state law requires me to provide proof that I am lawfully present in the United States prior to receipt of this public benefit. I further acknowledge that making a false, fictitious, or fraudulent statement or representation in this sworn affidavit is punishable under the criminal laws of Colorado as perjury in the second degree under Colorado Revised Statute 18-8-503 and it shall constitute a separate criminal offense each time a public benefit is fraudulently received.

Section II – Verification of Authorized Identification

Colorado state law also requires the applicant for a public benefit to produce to the City of Westminster one of the authorized identification documents listed below in order to verify lawful presence in the United States. The applicant may <u>either</u>: (1) produce such document in person at the City of Westminster; or (2) submit the fully executed and notarized form below along with a clear and legible copy of such document.

Please identify the authorized identification that you will submit (check only one):

- A valid Colorado driver's license or a Colorado identification card issued pursuant to Article 2 of Title 42, C.R.S., or
- A United States military card or a military dependent's identification card, or
- A United States Coast Guard merchant mariner card, or
- A Native American tribal document.
- Any additional form of identification authorized by the Executive Director of the Colorado Department of Revenue pursuant to § 24-76.5-103(5)(a), C.R.S. (valid only until March 1, 2007). Please list type of identification and expiration date.
