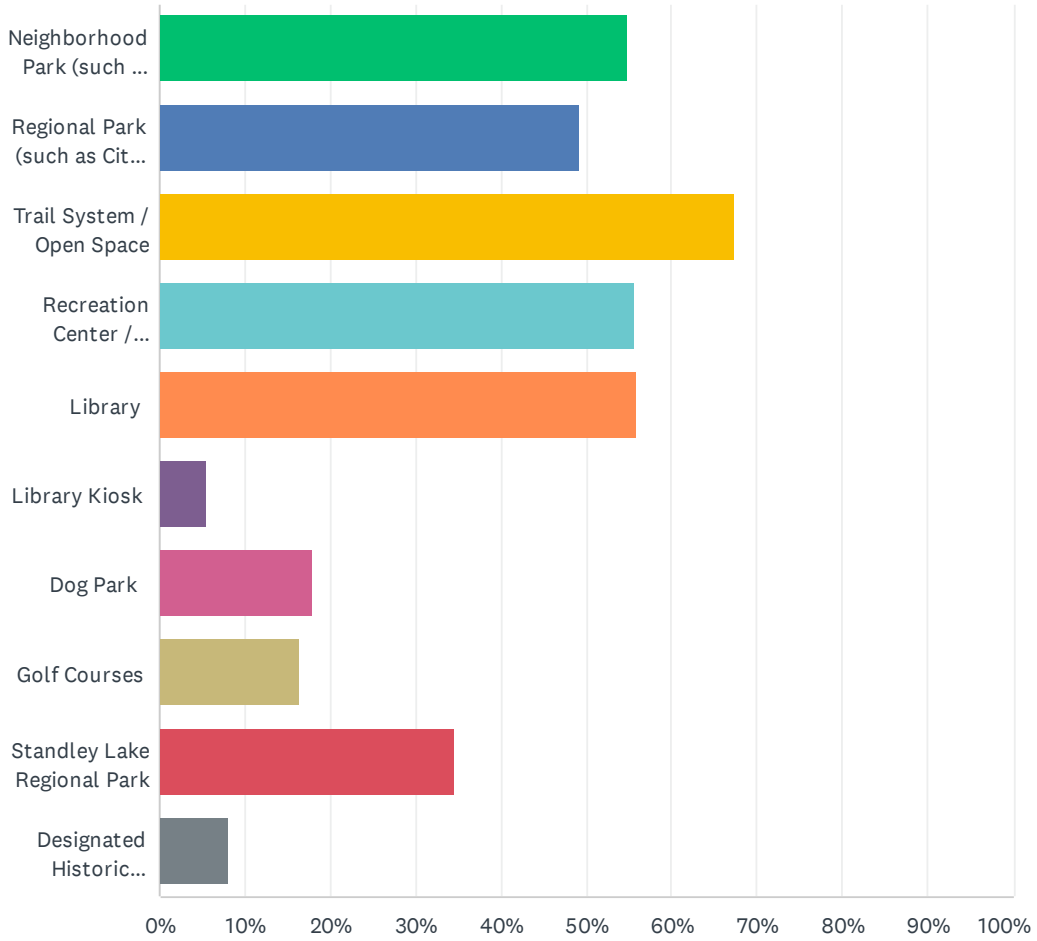


Q1 Which of the following PRL facilities do you regularly visit? (check all that apply)

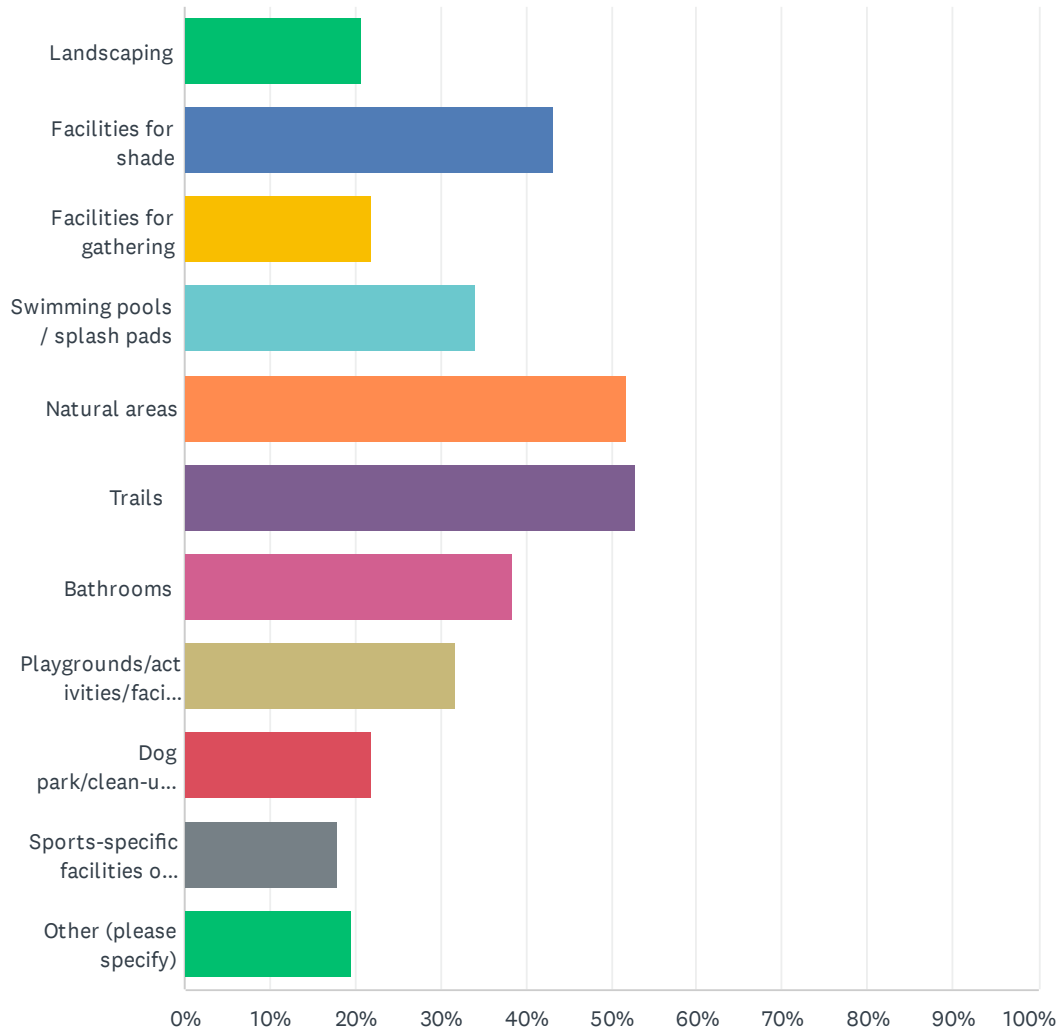
