HANDING OUT CANDY?



- Set up a treat table outside at the end of your driveway or patio
- Wrap individual treat bags, use pre-packaged candy and keep your workspace clean while creating bags

- Don't let kids reach into a bucket for their own candy

TRICK-OR-TREATING?

- Incorporate a mask into your costume
- Keep groups small (under 10) and limit house stops
- Bring hand sanitizer with you and use it often
- Keep your distance
- Don't reach into candy bowls and wait to eat candy until you get home

- Avoid parties (keep groups under 10)
- Staying home is safest option
- Consider having a spooky movie night or hide candy around the house
