




Q: As Westminster's retail shopping centers lose tenants and their viability as retail providers, what alternatives should be considered?






Q: How do you feel about the rate of growth and development in Westminster?















Turf grass uses more water than xeriscaping






90% of respondents answered correctly.



Restaurants use more water than retail commercial




