SLBT Update for the Week of October 14, 2019

- The tagging subcommittee met on Monday, October 7. The subcommittee was able to see the "production grade" Nokē lock that is currently being vetted by the internal SLBT. The integrated cable lock seems to be mechanically sound although software/firmware issues exist. The company that sells the Nokē lock reports that a new update for the lock could resolve issues and should be available to Staff to begin testing in January.
- Staff has been vetting the SecureXP lock, which is a tagging solution
 presented by the Tagging Subcomittee. The subcommittee, comprised
 of Staff and community stakeholders, does not fully agree that the
 Secure XP lock is a viable solution at this time. Through testing
 processes, Staff learned that the lock can be hacked in an undetectable
 manner. Others on the Tagging Subcomittee believe that the Secure XP
 lock is a viable solution and are recommending this to be pursued as a
 solution for the future.
- The tagging subcommittee will be presenting this option to the SLBT on Tuesday, October 15, 2019.
