Tagging Program	Incomplete	Critical	No cable system has proven detectable; Noke software/hardware issues unresolved - update from Noke in January
Tracking System	Incomplete	Critical	GPS and tracking related hardware and software (e.g. Noke) issues unresolved; policy related issues underway
Water Detection Sticker	Incomplete	Unknown	Depends on other solutions; no sticker has been found to be effective
One Boat One Lake	Incomplete	Unknown	Depends on other solutions; cost/policy/insurance/infrastructure/etc. reviews underway
Boat Modifications	Underway	Critical	Depends on tagging solution; Mussel Master Filter Approved
Raise Fees	Underway	Critical	Depends on tagging solution; New fees developed to recover all direct costs; Significant deposits are being planned
Increased Penalties	Near Completion	Critical	Fine thresholds established; lifetime ban supported; policy/procedures underway
State ANS Tracking Program	Done	Critical	Was already completed for the 2019 season
Decon Every Boat Every Time	Done	Not Feasible	This requirement would limit (estimated) 8 boats per day due to lengthy full decon process
Tracking Engine	Done	Not Feasible	This can be modified and turned off by boat owner
