

SLBT Update for the Week of July 15, 2019

- A cross-department team of city-wide staff has been identified and formed to further review the recommendations from the Standley Lake Boating Taskforce. This is important to moving forward the recommended solutions as the new solutions interface with several City departments.

SLBT Sub-Committee:

- Their meeting focused on the cable issues and identified specific action items.
- Two cable prototypes will be ordered that will have specific lengths, diameters, and laser etchings to review for the next meeting.
- The search for a manufacturer is underway for the T-handle for cable routing.
- One member is currently carving out a T-handle prototype out of aluminum.
- A planned “hacking” demonstration on an actual boat outside to replicate real time challenges will be scheduled for next meeting.
- Also, ordered are Nokē lock prototypes to review with the taskforce at their next meeting (not scheduled at this time).
- SLBT Sub-Committees next meeting will be scheduled sometime after July 26th and will be communicated via email.
