

SLBT Update for the Week of October 7, 2019

- The internal committee met on Monday, October 7 on several items including updates on any new findings on vetting of the Nokē lock system. Information Technology has been in contact with Nokē and reports that Nokē will be updating their software system come January, 2020, which up to this point has been unreliable. City Attorney's Office and Information Technology is in the process of reviewing legal language of the contract with Nokē.
- The Tagging Subcommittee met on Monday, October 7 to review vetting of the Secure XP lock along with a new cable and swage system. Staff supplied several examples of locks that had been hacked to the group. Feelings were mixed as to whether these locks would supply the security needed to bring power boats back to Standley Lake. FOSL will be writing up a proposal that will be presented to the SLBT next week that includes a "layered" locking system with both Secure XP and Nokē locks.
