CO 121/Wadsworth Boulevard Signal Improvement Project in Jefferson County

Traffic Update April 17 to April 21

Signal improvements will take place on CO 121/Wadsworth Boulevard at 66th Avenue and 87th Drive/84th Parkway in Arvada and on CO 121/Wadsworth Boulevard at 104th Avenue in Westminster.

Motorists Should Plan For:

- **CO 121/Wadsworth Boulevard at 104th Avenue**
 - Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. north, south, east and westbound right turn lane closure
 - Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. northbound right lane closure
 - Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. southbound right lane closure
 - Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. east and westbound right lane closure
- **CO 121/Wadsworth Boulevard at 87th Drive/84th Parkway**
 - Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. north, south, east and westbound right turn lane closure
 - Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. north, south, eastbound and right lane closure with a westbound full lane closure and detour
- **CO 121/Wadsworth Boulevard at 66th Avenue**
 - Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. north, south, east and westbound right turn lane closure
 - Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. southbound right lane closure
 - Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. northbound right lane closure
 - Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. east and westbound right lane closure
 - Thursday from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. intermittent traffic stops

Work will consist of striping and hanging mast arms.

Remember: Slow For The Cone

The following tips are to help you stay safe while traveling through maintenance and construction work zones.

- Do not speed in work zones. Obey the posted speed limits.
- Stay Alert! Expect the unexpected.
- Watch for workers. Drive with caution.
- Don't change lanes unnecessarily.
- Avoid using mobile devices such as phones while driving in work zones.
- Turn on headlights so that workers and other drivers can see you.
- Be especially alert at night while driving in work zones.
- Expect delays, especially during peak travel times.
- Allow ample space between you and the car in front of you.
