Why Transportation?

How employees, customers, products, and goods and services reach our business has a large impact on the health and wellbeing of the local community and environment. Ensuring that your vehicles are running properly, and encouraging and incentivizing biking, walking, and transit can do wonders for your bottom-line, encourage healthy employee commuting practices, improve air quality, and reduce greenhouse gas emissions. Driving Change: Top Opportunities

To begin, look at your operations and ask: How do employees, customers, and services access by business? How can my business reduce emissions and encourage low-carbon transit and commuting? Next consider the following:

Maintain vehicles: make sure vehicles are properly inflated and maintained

Post commuting resources: encourage driving alternatives by informing employees and customers about various transportation options (post bicycle route maps, transit schedules, online)

Install bike racks and electric vehicle (EV) charging stations

Set up a transit program: provide a carpool or carshare, bike share, and (RTD) <u>Eco-Passes</u> for employees to travel to and from work and meetings

Flextime: offer employees flexible work schedules, including compressed work weeks and telework or work from home options

Encourage Health Commuting: incentivize biking, walking, and transit through programs like <u>Bike-to-Work Day</u> and the <u>mywaytogo program</u>
