# WASTE REDUCTION SIMPLE ACTION GUIDE

## Why Reduce Waste?

By reducing your use of materials, you can save money, minimize carbon emissions from the production and consumption of materials, and promote a circular economy by using products longer.

## **Top Opportunities**

To begin, look at your operations and ask: What waste materials are recoverable or reusable? What waste could be easiest reduced/omitted?

**Increase digital correspondence:** adopt "paperless" receipts, paperless system for payroll/wvendors systems and print double-sided

Use reusables: provide durable food service ware (e.g., plates, cutlery)

**Source recyclables**: use easily recycled (e.g., aluminum) materials and purchase products that contain recycled content (particularly post-consumer not just preconsumer recycled content) to support markets for materials collected by recycling services and save natural resources

**Donate used or outdated items:** items like furniture and electronics can be a great fit for a new home or business

Purchase products in bulk: reduce packaging and shipping costs

**Source items that can be "remanufactured" or refurbished:** such products (e.g., toner cartridges, tires, furniture, and automotive parts) cost less and perform well. Also work with vendors to minimize or take back non-recyclable packaging and used/damaged products for reuse.

**Minimize single-use plastics:** where applicable prohibit items like plastic bags, straws, and plastic take-out containers

## Waste Reduction Resources: Make it Happen!

- •Set up a recycling service or drop off materials at the City's drop-off site
- •Drop off previously used items unfit for the landfill (furniture, metal, etc.) at the <u>Center for Hard to Recycle Materials (CHaRM)</u> in Boulder
