Why Water Efficiency?

Water is a precious and scarce resource in Colorado. Hot and dry summers and unpredictable winters makes water conservation an essential activity in the Front Range. While water conservation benefits the environment, it can also save your businesses money and time.

Top Opportunities

To begin, look at your operations and ask: Where do I use the most water? Where can I make easy changes that reduce my water bill? Next, consider:

Check for leaks – common leaks occur in toilets (check the flapper and fill valves) and sink faucets (check the rubber washers in the head).

Install Low-Flow Devices- faucets, toilets, sink aerators, and pre-rinse spray valves, and WaterSense labeled fixtures can reduce water use

Educate employees and customers to reduce water use- use signage and emails to encourage water-wise dish and hand washing

Time landscape watering- water in the early morning, evening, or night

Correctly zone your irrigation system- ensure your sprinkler only waters landscaped areas (not walkways and parking areas).

Use native and drought resistant plants- replace grass lawns and/or highwater usage plants (e.g., annual flowers) with native or xeriscape plants

Install rain shut-off devices or moisture sensors- prevent overwatering by turning off the irrigation system during rain events
