Sheridan Water Line Replacement Project

The Sheridan Water Line Replacement Project addresses concerns of age, condition, and capacity of the current water line along Sheridan Blvd. between 72nd and 80th Avenue.

Replacing the pipe will greatly reduce the potential for a water main break and ensures South Westminster residents along the Sheridan corridor will have better and more reliable water service.

IMPACTS MAY INCLUDE

- Temporary water shut offs
- Temporary lane closures
- Extended travel times and delays
- Noise, dust, and vibrations due to equipment
- Some nighttime work and intersection closures



WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Work is anticipated to begin as early as the week of June 20
- Active construction zone between 72nd Ave. and 80th Ave. on Sheridan Blvd.
- Work is anticipated from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday - Friday
- Minimum of one travel lane in each direction
- Advanced notice of planned water utility service disruptions. Emergency water shutoffs may happen, and we will notify those impacted and remain on site until service is returned
- Advanced notice will be provided before scheduled nighttime work and intersection closures
- Flaggers present during work hours to support traffic movement
- **Emergency access for residents and businesses will be maintained at all times during construction**

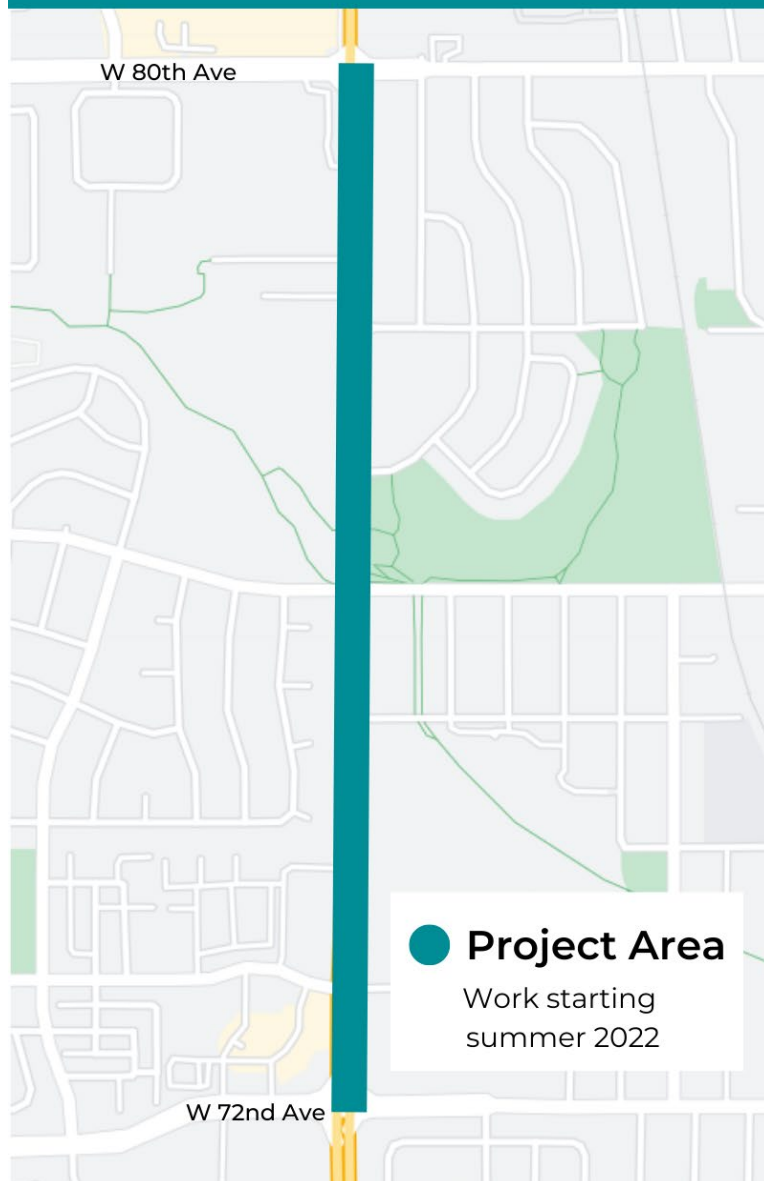
Project Elements

- Removing old pipe
- Installing new pipe
- Testing water flow
- Repaving work zone on Sheridan Blvd.
- Restriping work zone on Sheridan Blvd.

Frequently Asked Questions:

- **Will my water be shut off? If so, for how long?**
 - We anticipate shutdowns to last between 2-6 hours. Construction is unpredictable at times and if something changes while we are switching water service, we will notify businesses and residents.
- **Why do you need to shut off my water?**
 - When we transfer over water service to the newly installed water main, we will need to temporarily shut off water. Advanced notice will be provided to meters we anticipate temporarily disrupting.
- **Is my water safe to drink during construction?**
 - Yes, when we install a new water line, we ensure the water is clean and safe to drink before sending it to our customers. If you notice anything wrong with your water during construction, please contact 303-658-2500
