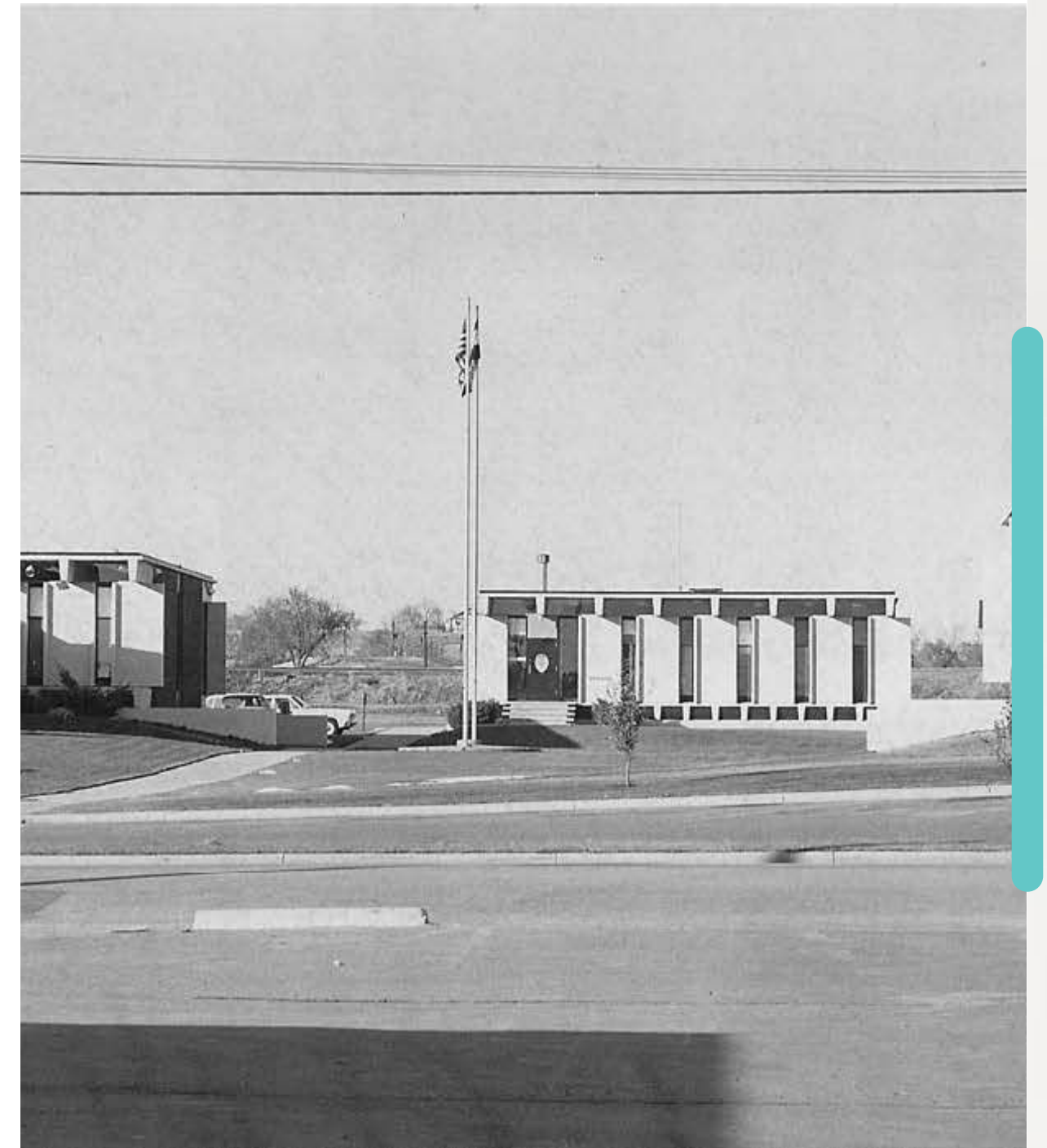


### **Specific areas of work of the Community Advisory Team may include:**

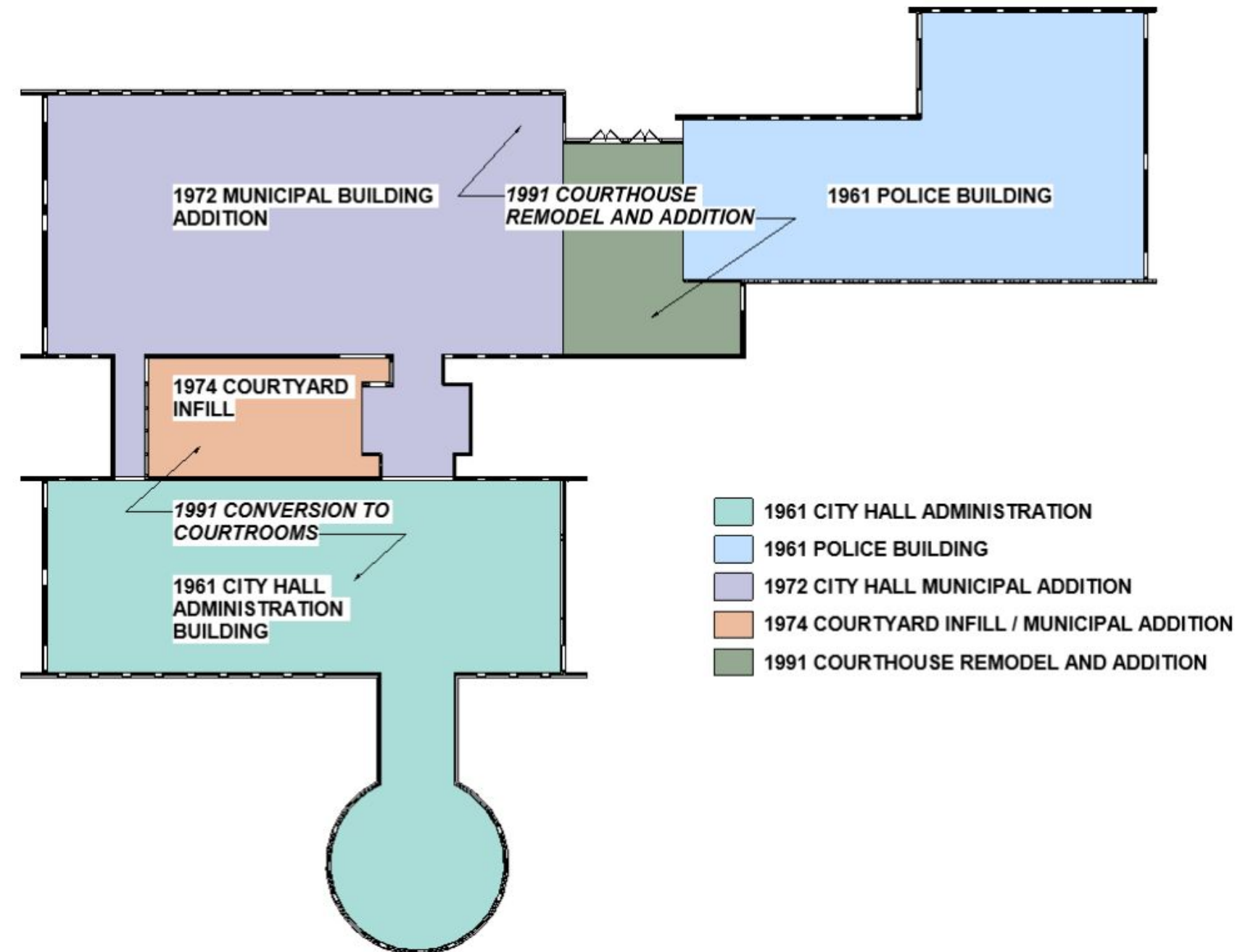

- The existing facility operations will continue throughout construction

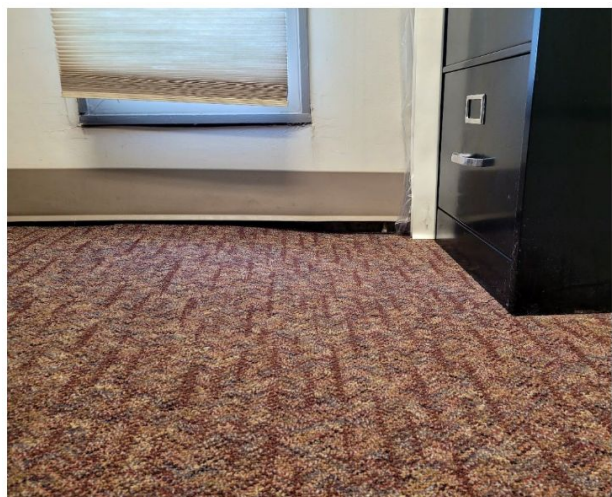
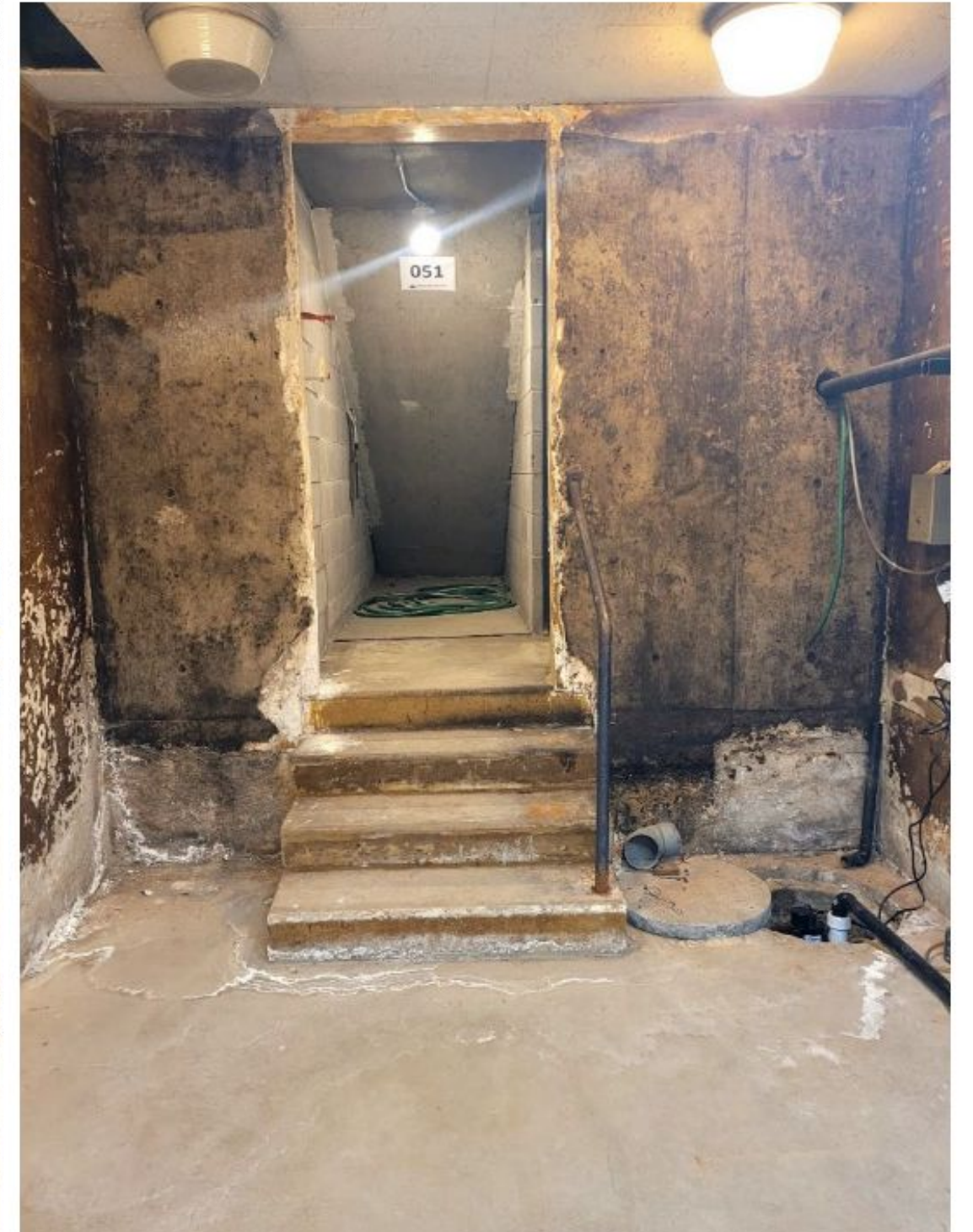




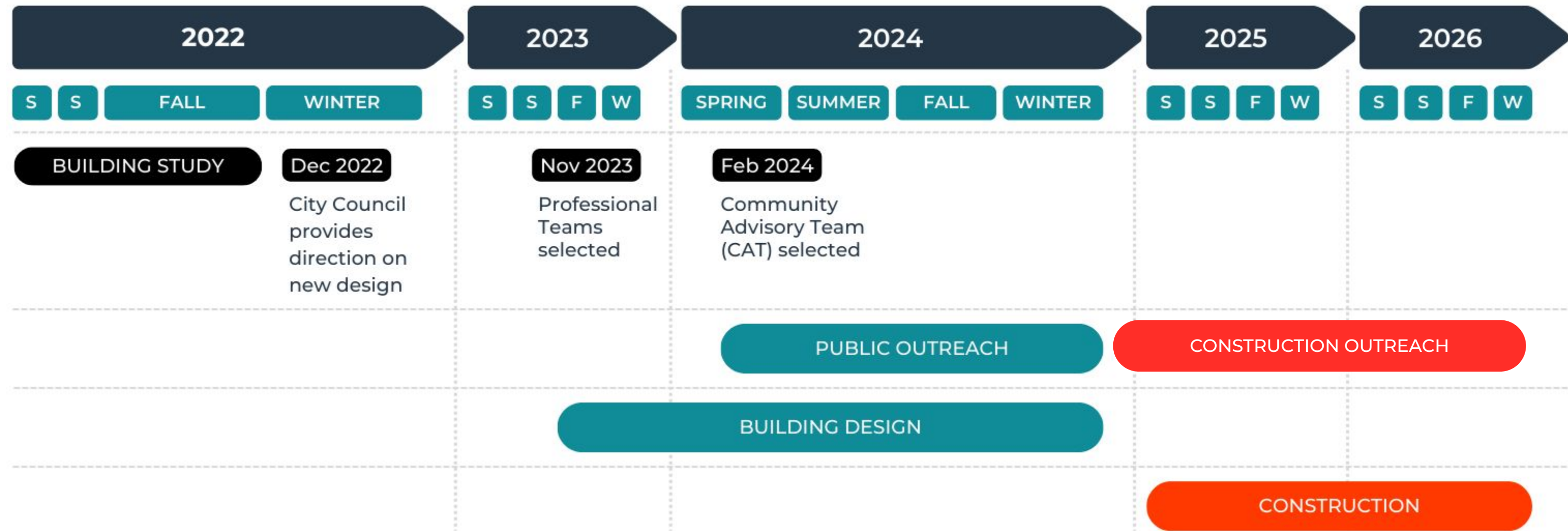
