01 Welcome & Recap














Parking Count

Sidewalk abruptly ends, leaving Turnpike Trail disconnected from the site








Consider safety

A uniform sidewalk and landscape feature could allow users to engage with the site's landscape and connect to Turnpike Trail








Potential extension of Turnpike Trail along the courthouse ROW

Currently, a sidewalk extending from Turnpike Trail is not a feature included on Turnpike Drive





Opportunity to relocate the playground further from Turnpike Drive vehicular traffic

Playground relocation consideration is heavily influenced by safety concerns present at Turnpike Drive

Maintain existing shade elements at the pickleball courts

The logic of shading elements will be considered throughout the site. Natural and built elements will be utilized to provide shade







Opportunity for larger/improved gathering space

A larger/ improved gathering space will inform the overall site design and enhance the user's experience









Maintain landscape buffers with low water native plantings

Buffers have the opportunity to populate more of site as the plan is developed









Opportunity for a new, updated playground space

Updates on current playground features could enhance the users experience and connection to the overall site







Consider pedestrian improvements to Holy Trinity Catholic Church/ W 76th Avenue

More definition given to pedestrian route will allow users to navigate more efficiently







Potential extension of Turnpike Trail along Grove Street

Extending Turnpike Trail on Grove Street would allow pedestrian access further into the neighborhood and site







Consider on-street parallel parking along W 76th Avenue







Consider the location of the courthouse entrance sign and flagpoles

Signage and flagpole placements could be adjusted to help the users navigate the new proposed building, correlating to an entry point









Opportunity to keep mature trees on the south side of the site and integrate this logic into the revised landscape plan

Tree placement can reinforce pedestrian wayfinding









Maintain vehicular access for residences from Grove Street








Consider removing disconnected walkways or provide additional connections


Analyzing the current pedestrian route can allow for updates of improved connection across the site







Consider addressing accessible parking stalls which do not meet ADA compliance







Consider drainage solutions using the southwest corner of the site at the low point








Improve inconsistent parking striping and assess parking configuration

Clearly defined parking spaces will keep the parking lot organized








Consider improvements to accessibility issues at the pickleball courts

Accessible improvements need to be made to the playground and pickleball courts so that the site is available to all users







Improve non-compliant ramp to pickleball courts







Consider addressing accessible aisles which do not meet ADA standards







Consider improvements which improve connections within the site boundary





Maintain newly installed infrastructure like the retaining wall at the pickleball courts







Consider alternative locations for dumpster access
